

DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT OF FUNDACIÓ JOAN COSTA I ROMA TO THE PRINCIPLES OF THE "EUROPEAN CHARTER FOR RESEARCHERS" AND THE "CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCHERS"

Consorti Sanitari de Terrassa (CST) is a public health care entity which comprises eighteen centres. The Fundació Joan Costa i Roma (FJCR) is the entity created within the CST in charge of the promotion and management of biomedical teaching, training, and research by healthcare professionals

The FJCR welcomes and supports the Recommendation of the European Commission 2005/205/EC on the "European Charter for Researchers" and the "Code of Conduct for the Recruitments of Researchers" (hereinafter referred to as the Charter and the Code). FJCR is fully in line with the efforts of the European Commission directed towards making the careers of researchers more attractive and transparent, and to fostering international cooperation in research and mobility of researchers.

By endorsing the Charter and the Code, FJCR recognizes the importance of the underlying principles and commits itself to implement them in its Human Resources Policy and management with the aim of guarantying transparency, accessibility and equity for the recruitment of researchers.

By adhering to this recommendation, FJCR both contributes to creating an adequate framework for the researchers and to the development of the European Research Area.
