International Participation

International participation is targeted in numerous topics

- Specific topics in calls for proposals may:
 - Indicate that participation of international partners is encouraged
 - Indicate that participation of partners from a certain country or region is encouraged or even mandatory



**Targeted
Opening**

“Each proposal shall target one country and region that is an established or emerging science, technology or innovation leader; proposals addressing all or part of Australia and New Zealand are strongly encouraged without excluding other countries with similar characteristics.”

Eligibility and admissibility conditions: described in [Annex B](#) and [Annex C](#) of the Work Programme.

Due to the specific challenge of this topic, in addition to the minimum number of participants set out in the General Annexes, proposals must include as beneficiary at least one legal entity established in the following countries: Australia or New Zealand.

2 PAGES ONLY!

- **Provide short/targeted information about your institution:**
 - ✓ a **description of the your institution and your competences**, with an explanation of how its profile matches the tasks in the proposal (**half page limit**)
 - ✓ **Short CVs** of the persons, including their gender, who will be primarily responsible for carrying out the proposed research and/or innovation activities; (**6 lines maximum**)
 - ✓ a **list of up to 5 relevant publications, and/or products, services** or other achievements relevant to the call content;
 - ✓ a **list of up to 5 relevant previous projects or activities**, connected to the subject of this proposal;
 - ✓ a description of any **significant infrastructure and/or any major items of technical equipment, relevant to the proposed work;**
 - ✓ **Include your logo & Contact details of your institutions (Name in English/national language, Acronym/ PIC number, full address, contact details (including email, phone...))**
