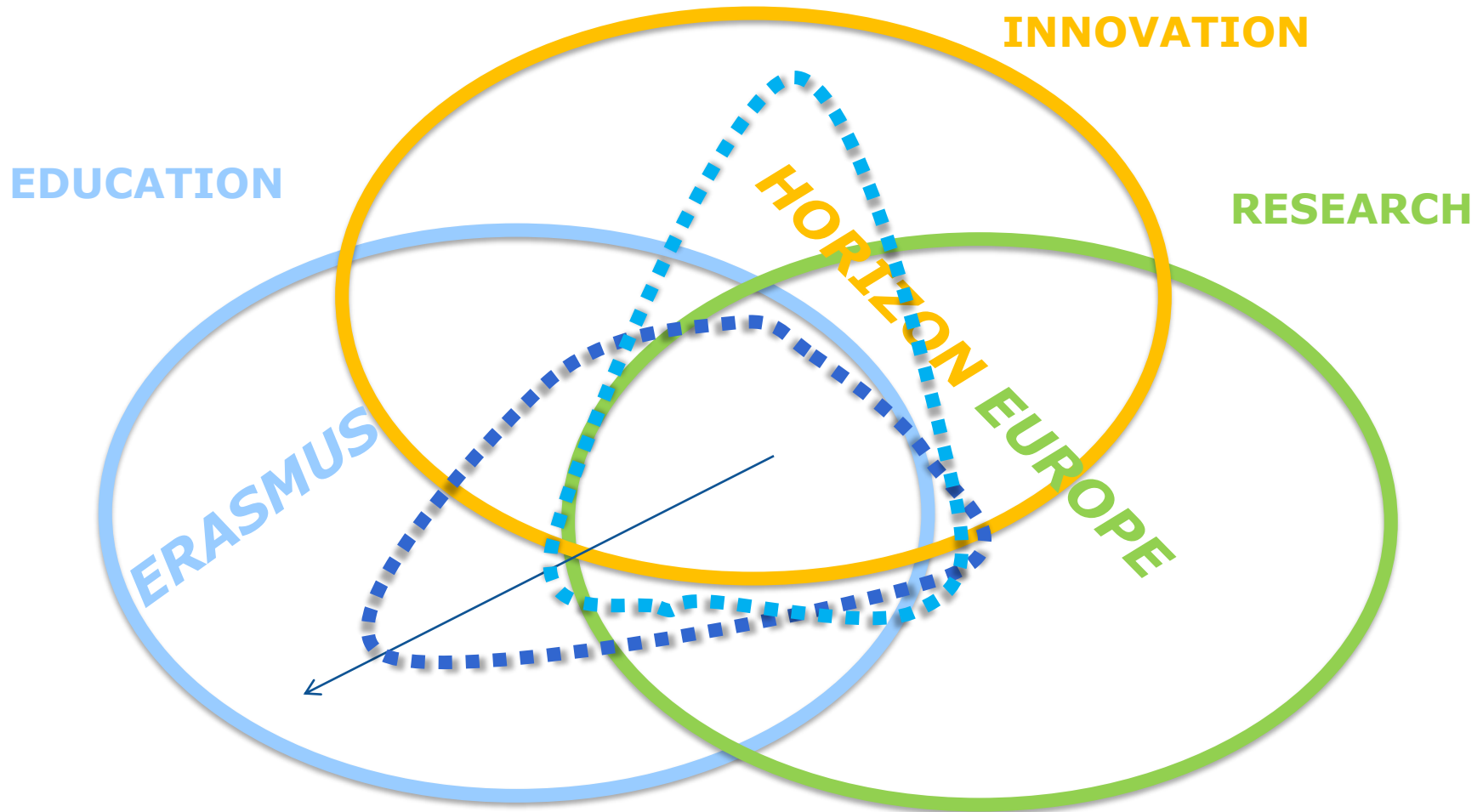
Build synergies between Horizon Europe & Erasmus (ERA and EHEA):

Policy actions within the HORIZON EUROPE 'Strengthening the ERA pillar'

- to support academic R&I - (European) universities while implementing Open Science and Entrepreneurship practices
- in order to improve the attractive career environments for researchers at all career stages

Proposed Instrument: Support scheme to induce systemic progress of (European) universities implementing OSI practices, based on a (European) university strategic plan; measuring progress from different compliance levels, using 4 Key Modules: *Skills Development; Entrepreneurship & Innovation; Inclusiveness, Efficient & Effective Systems*

Potential scheme for embracing Open Science and Entrepreneurship practices



- Objective: **enlarge the Open Science and entrepreneurship mechanisms in the crossroads of education, research and innovation**

The way forward on synergies and stakeholders engagement

- Build internal synergies at the level of existing and new instruments, such as European universities, EIC, ERC, EIT, MSCA, etc
- Conceptualise a (joint) supporting mechanism to embrace open science and entrepreneurship practices
- Organise workshops with common stakeholders as of Spring 2019
- Member State (ERAC / DG HE) meeting during Finnish Presidency in Autumn 2019
